Tree Pruning in the Park

On November 10, the beautiful old elm trees in the park will be getting some much needed maintenance. An arborist has been contracted to do limb weight reduction pruning. These trees will naturally drop huge limbs as they age, but we don't want limbs falling on the kayaks or on people enjoying the shade these trees provide. By carefully reducing the weight at the ends of the limbs, we hope to avoid such mishaps. The arborist will use a lift to get up to the branches and carefully lower portions to the ground. This process may be interesting for kids to watch if they are getting restless with their Zoom instruction. Some kayaks will need to be moved to protect them (the owners have been notified), and power lines around the trees will be taken down for a couple of days. With regular maintenance, we hope these trees will be healthy for decades to come.


- 1. Call ahead for an appointment, as only 1 member will be allowed in at a time.
- 2. If you forget to call ahead, just call from your vehicle or knock on the window or door and a staff member will come to unlock the door for you, if no other member is already inside.
- 3. There will be a table set in the lobby area to conduct business. <u>Please do not try to go further</u> from that point.
- 4. We want to make this as easy & safe as possible for everyone while keeping people out of the inclement weather.
- 5. Masks will always be required.



WE HAVE A LONE SEA LION HANGING AROUND

We all remember the noise and disruption of past years when we were invaded by Sea Lion. We've had a couple years without them, and that's definitely been a blessing. This year, we have a lone sea lion, one-eyed, sad-looking and quiet, but please remember that sea lions are big, capable of moving quickly, and can be dangerous, so stay at least 10 ft back from them. It is harmful and illegal to feed them because it changes their natural behaviors and makes them less wary of people and vessels.

Seal lions and seal are protected by law, but noise harassment to move them off the dock is allowed. Just remember to keep your distance while you yell, wave your arms, ring a bell, and/or bang a pan.
