### A Note from the Manager...

You may have noticed low water pressure or even slight water discoloration in the last week. We are experiencing some technical problems with our telemetry system. Telemetry is a fancy word for the communication system between our wells and our water tower. Currently, we are running the pumps manually and this added water pressure might cause iron and manganese from the pipes to discolor our water. If you experience this, we suggest running a garden hose to a drainage area and letting the water run for about 30 minutes. We realize this is an inconvenience. We are working with our IT company to remedy the situation. We regularly treat all drinking water with chlorine to treat any possible contamination. We also test our water quality through Thurston County regularly. Our water is safe to drink even when discoloration occurs.

Just a reminder, we are actively citing, and towing vehicles illegally parked in the park and clubhouse parking lots. Please make sure you and your guests have the appropriate permit displayed when parking at the clubhouse.

Noxious weeds are popping up throughout the property. We are removing Tansy Ragwort, Orange Hawkweed and other invasive or noxious weeds from our bioswales and common areas. If you have noxious weeds on your property, you must remove them immediately per Thurston County guidelines.
