LAUNCH GATE KEY TO CHANGE

The launch gate lock will be changed on Friday, July 1. To avoid having a key that does not work after that, members who currently hold a launch gate key may pick up a new key and fill out the new lease beginning **June**20. Old launch gate keys must be returned to the office no later than August 1. The cost for the new launch gate key will be \$ 20. Members who wish to get a launch gate key who do not currently have one will be charged a fee of \$25.00. Also, please note that there is a \$25.00 fee to replace a lost key, or a key not turned in by August 1.

HEADS UP FOR THOSE NEW TO THE CARLYON BEACH LAUNCH

Please watch your tides before trying to launch. Backing out beyond the launch dock can trap your trailer if you go off the concrete. Rule of thumb is to make sure there is water up to the launch dock for easier, safer launching.

LAUNCH PARKING ETIQUETTE

Both boaters and kayakers need to use the launch area to access the water. Due to limited space, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays, no vehicles without trailers will be allowed to park in the launch area, except for the disabled parking spot. Boaters trailering their boats can be up to 50 feet long and need room to maneuver when launching. Vehicles with trailers are not allowed in the upper lot.
