LAST MINUTES ITEMS

Parks and Rec have introduced a structure for rentals of the clubhouse and park grounds that is effective now!

Members in good standing may rent the club house at graduated rates depending on time renting for. The Park may be used for events as usual. For events that will have tents no more than 40 feet in length the impact fee will be \$300 per event. This fee is <u>nonrefundable</u>. The tents must be placed on the (west) side of the Wannigan closest to the kayak racks.

Rental of the clubhouse requires a \$ 300.00 deposit. The deposit will not be refunded if:

- The clubhouse is not cleaned after use, including garbage disposed of in the containers outside.
- The kitchen must be clean, with all items used put back in their place.
- The floors must be vacuumed, and the kitchen swept and any spills cleaned up.
- The bathroom in the clubhouse must be cleaned and waste basket emptied. If the bathrooms underneath the clubhouse or in the park are used, they must also be cleaned.
