#### Parks & Rec Report:

On July 10, 2025 the Parks Committee met and discussed the following:

Painting the new doors on the clubhouse, outdoor bathrooms and downstairs bathroom. Several colors were suggested and a few committee members met and decided to paint all doors white with the same trim color that is on the window trim of the clubhouse. The doors and trim will be painted during the month of August. The indoor/outdoor rug will be replaced in August as well.

The combination locks were discussed and agreed upon that the HOA needed them to prevent further vandalism. The locks have been installed and the combination given to the membership.

The dates of July 29 through August 1 the wanigan will be closed as the new composition roof will be installed. It was decided to go with 30-year composition roofing rather than metal. The wanigan has car decking underlayment, and it has to be removed and replaced with plywood. Had we stayed with metal it would add another \$4,000 to the cost. By using composition, the cost is only about \$2,000 more. The chimney will be refitted with flashing and shored up inside to prevent further leaking inside the wanigan. We are looking forward to many more years of use of this iconic structure in our park!

Sometime mid-August well house #2 will be painted and member's children under 10 will be invited to put their handprints with their name on the walls using different colors of paint. Next summer the playground equipment at well #2 will be replaced as well.

It was decided not to try and terrace and replant the slopes from the clubhouse down to the marina as it would be very costly and the ivy holds the earth (clay) "in". We looked at many different options to improve the slopes but decided to keep the ivy. It will be pruned every spring to keep the area looking nice and tidy.

It was noted that there are still a lot of dogs taken into the park and it was suggested the fines be increased. Increasing the fines is being considered. Please be aware that taking a dog into our park is a liability to the HOA. Not allowing dogs in the park is nothing new to our community, taking a dog through the park on the way to the beach is included in the "NO Dogs in Park". A key to the small gate at boat launch is only \$25.00 a year and our dogs love the beach we have! Dogs on leash ARE allowed to be taken down the driveway to the marina to board their owner's boat!

That's it from Parks for July, thank you!
