- IV. Mike Cooper moved and Sandi Allen seconded to accept Stephanie Greene's resignation from the board. Passed.
- V. Sandi Allen moved and Mike Cooper seconded to accept and seat Lars Swartling on the board. Passed. Welcome aboard Lars.
- VI. Rick Gamas moved and Sandi Allen seconded to approve the June 26, 2018 minutes as amended. Passed.

- VIII. President's Report- Margaret DesRochers
 - a. A new laptop computer was ordered to provide another work station.
 - b. Identifying lettering for CBHA staff jackets is being prepared by Mary Saurs.
- IX. Roads and Storm Water- Mike Cooper Lisa Krupp moved and Sandi Allen seconded to approve up to \$95,000 to repair sections of Mariner Drive and Crestridge Drive from the restricted capital fund and the unrestricted capital fund. Passed 5-1.

- XI. Marina- Sandi Allen Sandi reported that we are in the process of repairing some wood siding so that new equipment can be attached to the dock.
- XII. **Architecture- Rick Gamas** reported that two new fences and a driveway have been approved for homeowners.
- XIII. Parks and Recreation-Lisa Krupp reported that there is a possibility of a community sponsored 'sleepover' in the park. More news to follow. Lars Swartling was appointed the new Parks and Recreation director.
- XIV. Operations Manager's report- Chuck Toler

 - d. Log boom repair is no longer needed as the issue self-corrected.
 - **e.** Locating our water mains will require finding companies willing to make bids on the project.
 - f. The bioswales are in good shape and the county complimented our up-keep.
