President's Message

Well, I'm happy to say that February is behind us and, hopefully, the snow! Again, a thank you to **Seth Shade** for calling and volunteering to run our backhoe/plow to clear all the CBHA roads. Little did I know that when I spoke to him Tuesday night he was going to start that night and clear the two main arteries to our community. Great job and "thank you" Seth.

We have a new manager, **Steve White**. He comes to us with a military and strong management and education background. Please read his introduction on the first page of the newsletter. Also, he will be available for a "meet and greet" at the March Koffee Klatch on March 13th.

We have hired a new employee, **Steve Durgan** to replace Brendon who resigned last month. Steve has a CDL and will be our 3rd (backup) pump truck driver and a maintenance employee.

Some of our Marina, kayak and boat launch will be increasing for our next fiscal year. The Marina fees will be increased to \$3 a foot for all slips except the 18' slips which will increase on a sliding scale for 3 years. The kayak fees will be \$12' for the size rack you are renting. The 3' racks will be \$36, just a \$1 per year increase. We will be returning to our old policy of charging annually for the boat launch key. It will be \$20 a year. A new lock with new keys will be purchased. The old locks will no longer be used.

Members moving their pump out connection to the road and members improving/refurbishing their pump out connection will receive one free pump to encourage members to be proactive on keeping their connections in good repair for our drivers.

The By-Law change deadline is March 7th. Please contact Marcia at the office for the correct form to use for changes. Also, please submit your changes to Marcia at the office.

The deadline to submit applications to run for the Board are due in the office by 4:30 April 4th. Applications are available at the office or can be emailed to you, just call and request one. There are 3 openings to be filled this year.

Increased fees for kayak racks and launch gate key

At the February 26 Board meeting, the trustees voted to increase the fees for the kayak racks and to reimplement an annual fee for a key to the launch area. The kayak fee has not changed in at least 18 years. Obviously, maintenance and administrative cost have increased over that time. In addition, each rack paid the same fee which seemed inequitable. The new fees are based on the size of the rack.

Annual fee for kayak racks:

3 ft rack \$36 4 ft rack \$48 5 ft or larger \$60

If you would like to change racks or give up your rack due to this increase, please let the office know as soon as possible. Over the next few weeks, we will be renumbering the racks to incorporate the new racks in a more logical numbering system.

A **\$20** annual fee for the launch gate key is necessary due to the increased cost of maintaining the parking area and the dock itself. Also, it has become necessary to purchase a new padlock and set of 400 keys for that gate which costs about \$1,200. Billing and key exchange will occur in July.
